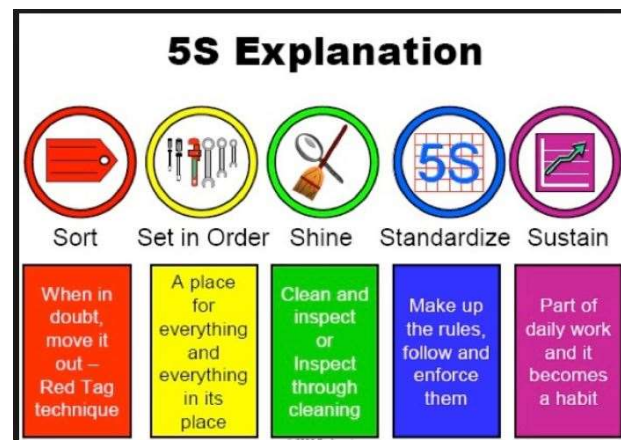

Top management is not only focusing on quality management but also pursuing continuous improvement, which is one of the main key major contributors to increasing shopfloor productivity, and product or service quality. Nowadays organizations are focusing on success through productivity improvements and cost reductions by shop floor management activities.

For this, many best practices methods are adopted and implemented by companies to meet their objectives. in shop floor management. This practice gives the best space utilization, quality, highest productivity, cost reduction, best morale, and safe work environment, etc.

To add with another avenue to showcase and share the 5S best practices deployed in all sectors of Indian industries to remain competitive on the Global level, CII – Institute of Quality is launching the “5S Competition”. The Competition includes the improvements carried out across the organization by different departments as well as groups of people and people from different levels making it unique by eliminating all types of waste and improving the workplace conditions.

5S competition would have the following categories as given below:

Category - 1: Manufacturing Industry

Comprises of

- Production Floor
- Maintenance Stores
- Office
- Canteen
- Raw Material & Finished Goods Stores
- IT Server Area

Category - 2: IT & Service Industry

Comprises of

- Information Technology Service Providers
- Hospitals, Laboratory and Medical Shops
- Spare Parts Business
- Service Centers (all type of OEM Product service centers)
- Educational Institutions (Schools, Universities, Colleges..)
- Theme Parks
- Hotels, Spas & Restaurants
- Commercial, Super Markets
- Petrol Bunks
- Conference Center and Entertainment places (Cinema theaters)
- Travels and Tourism
- Airport, Metro Bus stands & Railway Stations
- Beauty care centers
- Health physical care centers (Gym, yoga center, etc.)

Category- 3: Industrial Surroundings

Comprises of

- Security and Admin Systems
- ETP & STP Areas
- Fire Fighting Systems
- Fuel Storage Yard
- Hazardous Materials storage area
- Gardening

The categories have been strategically considered at the 5S Competition so that all sectors of industries and all levels of employees in the organization namely, operators, middle management, and senior management are covered and can showcase their best activities and compete.

The companies can nominate their best-case studies with a maximum of 2 members per case study. As the competition is open for all above-mentioned categories for all sectors, we request members to nominate case studies from these areas.

Criteria:

- The presentation can be done in English or Hindi. Preferably English. The presenters should be from the Zone Leader and members.
- The 5S Competition would showcase the activities successfully implemented and sustained properly.
- This letter is a call for papers for the 5S Competition being organized on 17-18 Oct 2024 through Virtual Platform.
- Last date to submit the call for papers for 5S competition is 7 Oct 2024. Intimation of selected paper to company on or before 15 October 2024.
- The Platinum Winners of this Competition will take part in Champions' Trophy 2024.
- Panel of Judges will evaluate the 5S activities nominated & selected case studies should be presented at the Competition.
- The TPM Club India has all rights to take the final decisions with regards to number of trophies & final assessments.
